The Ambulance Housie was first established on the corner of Ocean Parade and The Entrance Road and operated from a huge canvas tent. The seats were rough and the long tables accommodated the players. In addition there was a chocolate wheel and the 'doggies', which was a small artificial circular race track where the metal dogs were lined up, and with a tap of the handle, 'they were off,' and the first past the post was the winner. Household goods were offered as prizes throughout the carnival. Added attractions added lustre. It was manned by volunteers. Later the carnival moved to the opposite side where it remained for several years. It has long been demolished.
