Affectionately accepted as one of The Entrance's favourite sons. In his debut test and first innings in 1934, Arthur was 99 not out at lunch. He had the misfortune of being bowled out on the 3rd ball of the 1st over after the interval. He was an outstanding slips fieldsman and a useful spin bowler. His best bowling performance for the Australian eleven against the visiting M.C.C. team was when he captured 8 wickets for 66 runs in 1936.
