Barton's Circus and Barton's Follies were a part of the history of The Entrance. Frank and Matilda Barton owned the circus, while their sons Lindsay and Roy became well known local identities. With the onset of World War II, Lindsay joined the Tivoli circuit which is where he met his wife Cherrie, a wardrobe mistress. The world of entertainment was the Bartons life, so it was not a surprise when Lindsay set up a children's carnival in the Main Street of The Entrance. Later they built an indoor carnival on the site adjacent to the Catholic Housie. It featured a range of amusements including mini golf, laughing clowns, hoop la and childrens rides.
