

H.M. CHALMERS CHEMIST



Located at 56 The Entrance Road, The Entrance.



In 1929 a young chemist, Hilton Chalmers was working for Joe Boyer's Chemist shop in Wyong. In 1929 Mr Boyer established a branch and then a shop at The Entrance next door to the Prince Edward Theatre. The young Hilton Chalmers later purchased the business and operated it successfully until his death. The shop was passed on to his son, Malcolm who was also a chemist. The shop later burned down, so Malcolm relocated the business to the Argyle Centre at Toowoan Bay.

Malcolm Chamers went on to become one of the most popular Wyong Shire Council Presidents. Tragically he was killed in a motor vehicle accident outside of Kempsey NSW.
