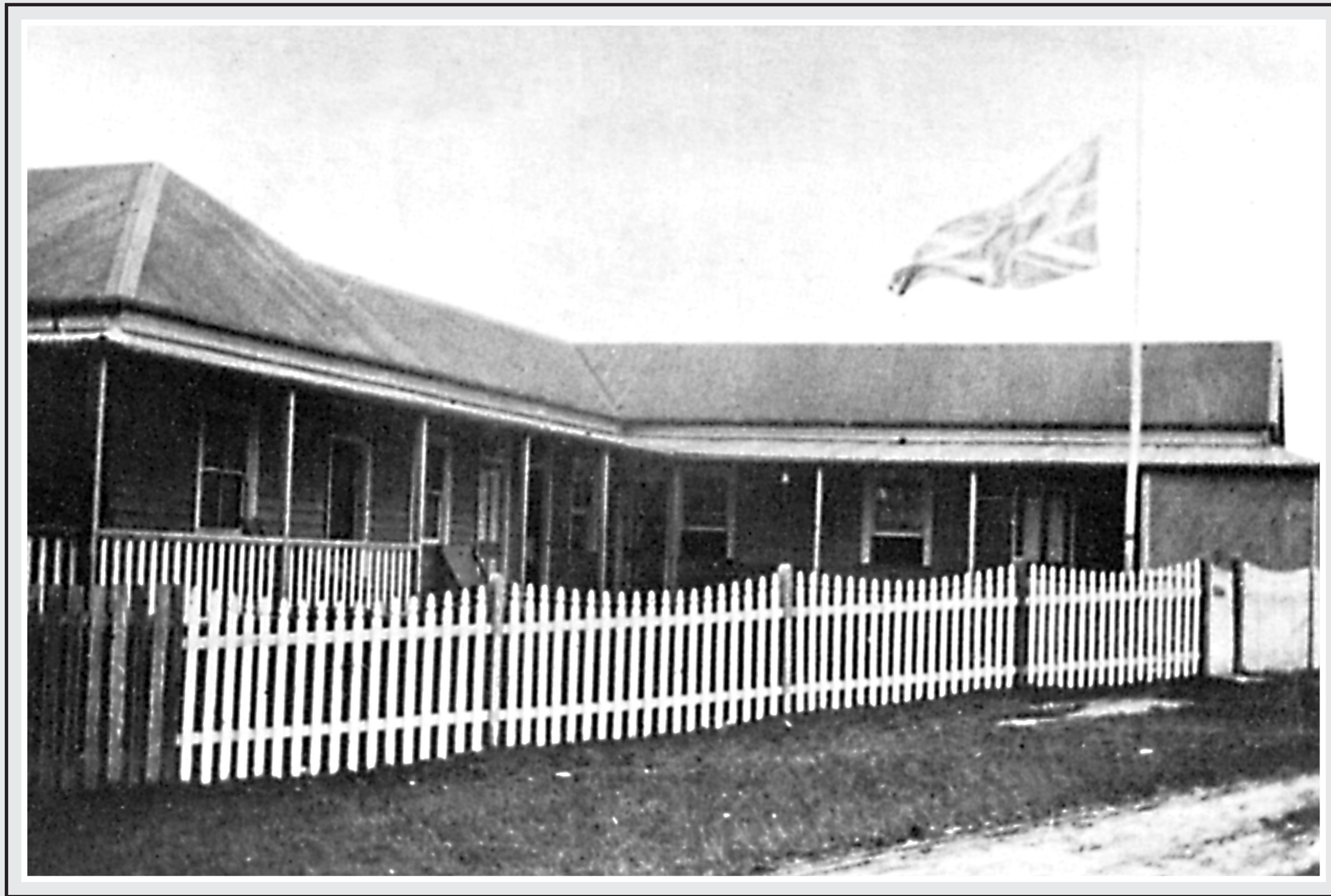


# KOONYA GUEST HOUSE



Located just west of The Entrance Bridge on The Entrance Road and overlooking the lake.

Was built as a general store and post office by Vincent Taylor (son of Richard and Gertrude Taylor). Vincent later converted the store into 'Koonyah' Guest House for Miss Rachael Davis. Rachael had previously leased 'Dunleith' Guest House at The Entrance North. It is interesting to note that Miss Davis was the first woman in The Entrance to be awarded a Certificate of Merit from the RSL for her splendid work during World War I for 'providing comforts to the 1st AIF'.

A true patriot, Rachael flew the Australian Flag at 'Koonya' Guest House every day. Rachael Davis retired in April 1935.
