

LAKESIDE GUEST HOUSE

Built in 1923 by Laura (Rene) Nicol (daughter of Richard and Gertrude Taylor).

'Lakeside' Guest House was the most modern of all of the guest houses built in The Entrance. It boasted electric light and was beautifully furnished throughout with oak panels. In 1945 Jim and Rita Nicol purchased the property from Jim's mother. It had an outstanding reputation for its wonderful cuisine. The Nicol's also offered clean comfortable furnished cottages in addition to a well appointed caravan park.

On 4th March, 1989 the property was sold to Geno Corporation for \$1.4m. After the sale; the guest house building was moved to a rural location at Gwandalan.

The land is earmarked for future development.
