

# NEWLINGS BAKERY



Located opposite the intersection of The Entrance Road and Dening Street.

Reginald and Muriel Newling established their third bakery in December 1932. It was located in The Entrance. They made their first deliveries to customers in a two-horse drawn bread cart. All ingredients were mixed by hand, the dough was prepared the previous evening and left to sit for 5 to 6 hours. It was then placed in the wood fuelled ovens to be baked into crisp fresh bread.

During the holiday period, the Newling's enjoyed a roaring trade as shown in the photograph above. They continued to operate the business until 1952 when they sold it to Doug Goode, who later sold it to Buttercup bakeries.
