

RELOCATING THE OLD PRESBYTERY



Fr. Brennan purchased the cottage known as 'St. Ives' which was located next door to the Catholic Church in 1947. He finally moved into the Presbytery in March 1948, after having lived at the Lakes Hotel 'with a good Catholic family'. He paid his own rent to the hotel.

The Presbytery was relocated to 29 Norfolk Avenue, The Entrance to allow for the construction of the current Presbytery.
