Henry (Harry) Seargent and his two sons Wesley and Allan came to The Entrance in September 1935. The family purchased Carlyon's Pioneer Bus Service and re-named it Seargent's Blue Bus Line. It operated between The Entrance and Wyong. When they began operations, the Seargents owned five buses and by the 1940's the service expanded and took in Long Jetty, The Entrance, Toowoong Bay, Blue Bay, North Entrance, Tacoma, Rockey Point, Tuggerawong, Wyongah, Wallarah Point, Toukley, Noraville, Norah Head, Swansea, Budgewoi, Buff Point and Kanwal.

It seems the Company had several names which included Seargent's Blue Bus Lines, Seargent's Tuggerah Lakes Bus Lines, Seargent's Blue and White Bus Lines and Seargent's Transit Company.
