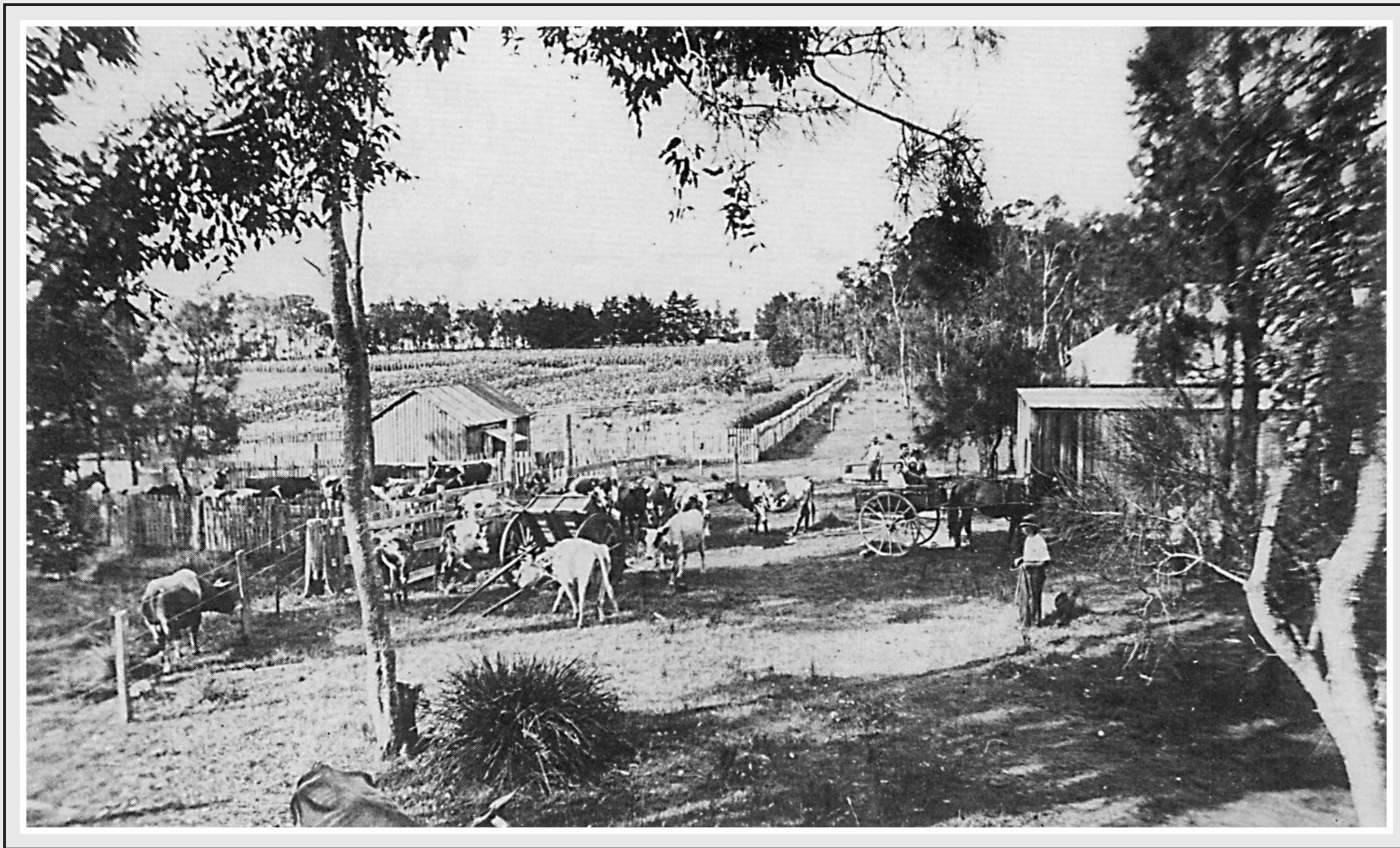


THE ENTRANCE DAIRY



About 1916 Raymond Clyde Taylor established a dairy at The Entrance on a 53 acre property he had acquired from his father. In the holiday season he sold the milk locally to the guest houses in bulk for fifteen pence a gallon, and in small quantities to campers in tents and to householders for fivepence a quart.
